Self-Assessment for Acute Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI)

IMPORTANT: **If you feel you have been exposed to HIV within the last 72 hours, please let our medical staff know. You may qualify for Post Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) to prevent becoming infected with HIV***

Please note, Express STI screening should only be done if you are not experiencing any symptoms of an STI. If you suspect you may have an STI, you will need to be examined and treated by a medical professional and do not qualify for Express STI Testing. If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, please ask us to schedule you an appointment with one of our providers. If we do not have any available appointments today, we will refer you to the nearest Urgent Care clinic.

- Abnormal penile discharge (thick, yellow-white, milky or watery)
- Abnormal vaginal discharge (may have an odor)
- Painful urination or ejaculation
- Burning sensation during urination
- Frequent urge to urinate
- Bumps, rash, warts, lesions or sores on or around your genitals
- Rectal discharge, bleeding or pain
- Sore throat
- Flu-like symptoms
- Rash on or around genital area
- Single firm, round, painless sore (chancere)
- Painful sores on or around your genitals and/or mouth
